

**TOWN OF TROY
TOWN CAUCUS**

January 16, 2021

The 2021 Town of Troy caucus was called to order by chairman, Jeff Lohr, at 1:00 p.m., on Saturday, January 16, 2021, at the Town of Troy town hall. Those in attendance were asked to sign in giving their name and address. Eighteen (18) logged in with eighteen (18) eligible to vote.

Because Lohr intends to be a candidate for chairman for the 2021-2023 term, Ed Larsen made a motion, seconded by Brad Anderson, to nominate Greg Sprecher as caucus chairman. Motion carried 18-0.

Carol Anderson made a motion, seconded by Andrew Sprignoli, to select the candidates by paper ballot. Motion carried 18-0.

Sprecher made a motion, seconded by Lohr, nominating JoAnn Ballweg and Aaron Anderson, as the tellers. Motion carried 18-0.

The following are the results of the voting:

Town Chairman: Jeff Lohr, 17; 1 no vote.

Supervisor #1: Brad Anderson, 17; Tom Ederer, 1.

Supervisor #2: Ed Larsen, 12; Greg Sprecher, 4; Don Meise, 1; Tom Ederer, 1.

Town Treasurer: Lloyd E. Ballweg, 17; 1 no vote.

Town Clerk: Mary Zins, 18.

The top two candidates will be on the April 6, 2021, ballot when all necessary paperwork has been submitted to the town clerk.

Brad Anderson made a motion, seconded by Kathy Lohr, to adjourn. Motion carried 18-0.

The caucus adjourned at 1:20 p.m.
