

**TOWN OF TROY
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING**

November 12, 2024

After the budget hearing, the special town meeting was called to order at 7:55 p.m., by Chairman, Jeff Lohr, at the Town of Troy town hall. There were nine (9) in attendance.

Greg Sprecher made a motion, seconded by Jeff Lohr, to approve the agenda as posted. Motion carried 9-0.

Brad Anderson made a motion, seconded by Greg Sprecher, to approve the November 14, 2023, special town meeting minutes. Motion carried 9=0.

Lloyd E. Ballweg made a motion, seconded by Tonya Anderson, to accept the 2025 budgeted town levy of \$312,948.00. Motion carried 9-0.

Greg Sprecher made a motion, seconded by Brad Anderson, to approve the budgeted highway expenditures of \$299,460.00 for 2025. Motion carried 9-0.

Taking effective for the 2025-2026 term, the following motions were made to increase the salaries for the following:

1. Tonya Anderson made the motion, seconded by Lloyd E. Ballweg to increase the **town chairman** salary from \$5,000 to \$6,000 yearly plus \$45/per diem. Motion carried 9-0.
2. Tonya Anderson made the motion, seconded by Gregory Sprecher, to increase the **town treasurer** salary from \$10,000 to \$11,000 yearly. Motion carried 9-0.
3. Tonya Anderson made a motion, seconded by Lloyd E. Ballweg, to increase the **town clerk** salary from \$19,000 to \$20,000 yearly. Motion carried 9-0.

The minutes of the November 14, 2023, stated the township was not in compliance with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue regarding market value assessments. Since then, the town's assessor, Associated Appraisal, has completed a full evaluation and the township is in compliance with the state.

Seeing there were no other further town issues, Gregory Sprecher made a motion, seconded by Jeff Lohr, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 9-0.
